The USE has long occupied a stable place in the educational system. Introduced as a trial form of the exam, the USE later became the main option for passing the state final certification of graduates. Its distinctive feature is that its results can count as an entrance exam for universities. This is both a plus and a minus of the USE. Every year the tasks become more and more complicated, and only 5 per cent of pupils pass the essay on humanitarian subjects. Take social studies, which at first glance seems a fairly easy subject. But it is only at first glance.

In our article we will consider the criteria of the essay on social studies, its structure, whether the grading system will change in the future year 2021, as well as how points are awarded for the essay. To successfully pass the paper on it, the student should take his time, be attentive to details and follow a certain plan.

Of course, the most important thing is experience. It is necessary to write as many essays on humanities topics as possible. While a flight of fancy and figurative language is welcome in a Russian language essay, a paper on social studies often answers a specific question and should contain a certain logic, facts and arguments.

Choose your topic carefully, preferably the one in which you really have a good understanding. Do not stop at a philosophical topic, it is often the most difficult.

Having chosen a topic, before you start writing, sketch in the form of a thesis all the knowledge you have on it. The more the better.

Then you should sketch a preliminary plan for the future work. Consider in detail how to do this.

Any plan has its own structure. The social studies essay is no exception. It should include the following elements:

1) Introduction

It should reveal the relevance of the chosen topic, as well as give a brief account of the author of the statement. Also mention the sphere to which the quote can be attributed. 2) Main part.

1) More often includes arguments that help to most fully describe the problem. At least three aspects of theoretical disclosure of the topic should be mentioned.

2) Practical arguments. It is also possible to give examples from life. Any cases that fit the topic.

3) Conclusion:

Return to the formulation of the statement itself or to the problem of the statement. Draw a conclusion from it.

The conclusion should consist of two parts: your statements and thoughts as a conclusion. This is followed by a return to the topic.

How to get the highest score?

Writing a social studies essay for the highest score is not easy, but it is possible. The main thing that is appreciated is the logicity of the text, the ability not just to use the available knowledge, but to skillfully operate with arguments and facts, confirming your opinion. By the way, the best option when writing a paper on social studies is to choose the statement that is closest to you and follow the path of least resistance - that is, agree with the author's statement and just develop his idea. Also be careful when writing, check your essay several times for spelling, stylistic and other errors. You may be forgiven one mistake, but even a great idea written in sloppy language will make the teachers lower your scores.

You should roughly understand the essence of the statement and not only disclose it most fully, but also apply most of your knowledge of social studies. But remember, only 1.5 hours at most are allowed for the essay, so you should not "flow with thought" either.

It is also better to practice writing essays in advance. The most common topics in the exam are from the field of economics, law, philosophy, political science and law.

Grading Criteria in 2021

In order to pass the final paper in social studies perfectly, it is also important to know the criteria by which the essay will be evaluated.

In 2021, they differ little from the 2018 criteria and follow the following standards:

The criterion, which takes into account how fully the meaning of the statement is revealed by the student. Here, one point is awarded out of a possible six points. The author of the work must reveal ideas related to the social studies course and formulate at least a couple of theses, which should then receive a logical justification. Points for this criterion will not be awarded if you simply retell the expression of the author or your main idea does not fit it.

The criterion, which deals with the theoretical part of the chosen topic. It gives two points, and you should make a special effort when writing it. In essence, you have to give scientific justification of your thesis. General reasoning without the application of social science knowledge automatically leads to lower scores.

The third criterion evaluates the logicity of your conclusions and reasoning, made with the support of the disclosure of the key points of the essay. Theoretical reasoning is logical and does not contradict the general logic. One point is given for the theoretical part.
