Financing Your Education

With all but 3 of our partner universities (ICMS, Lincoln University and University of South Australia), you can use U.S. financial aid (in the form of Federal/Stafford loans) to finance your education. Of course, the amount of aid that you are eligible for is determined by multiple factors, and thus it is hard to anticipate this amount prior to receiving an offer to the institution overseas. There are also scholarships available through the universities overseas that are specifically designated for International Students. In most cases, there are more funding opportunities at the Master's/PhD level.

Basic Entry Requirements/Materials That Will Need to Accompany Your Application

- Application
- Application Fee, if applicable (see chart for more information:(<http://www.degreesoverseas.com/how-we-help/application-faqs/application-fees/>)
- Transcripts

If you have completed your Bachelor's or Master's:

- Official undergraduate transcript (This includes all colleges and/or universities your attended)
- Those who have completed a graduate degree need to include their graduate transcripts in addition to their undergraduate transcripts

If you have completed some college coursework:

- If you have more than 30 college credits, you just need undergraduate transcripts
- If you have fewer than 30 college credits, you need both undergraduate and high school transcripts (U.S. students will also need to include official SAT/ACT scores)

If you have completed high school:

- Official high school transcripts (U.S. students will also need to include official SAT/ACT scores)
- Standardized Test Scores

U.S. high school graduates and U.S. students with fewer than 30 college credits

- Official SAT/ACT scores

Passport Copy

- For Australian schools, a photocopy is fine unless otherwise noted.
- For New Zealand schools, the photocopy must be notarized to be considered "certified." This is required for all NZ students in order to process the application.

Letters of Recommendation, Resume/CV/Personal Statement

- Only required if listed in the admission requirements of the prospectus
- Referee reports are required for some research degrees as well as various graduate law and business programs.
